Parents of Clymer Elementary School,

It has come to our attention that two Clymer Elementary students have flu-like symptoms and may have been exposed to family members who had returned from an Asian country that has a coronavirus outbreak. At this time, neither the students nor the family members have tested positive for coronavirus. In fact, no student, family or staff member has tested positive for the virus. **However, to be overly cautious, and to take every precautionary measure, we will close school for Thursday, March 12 and Friday, March 13. We will reopen on Monday, March 16.**

During the closing, the building will undergo an extremely thorough disinfecting cleaning so that all surfaces are cleaned thoroughly. We will also monitor the situation. If you believe your child may have been exposed to the coronavirus and is showing symptoms, please call the school at (215) 223-2243 and inform us. Symptoms include fever, cough, and shortness of breath.

Again, this is only a precautionary measure. If circumstances change or any member Clymer staff or students test positive for the virus, we will contact you immediately and potentially extend the closure. We do not expect that to happen.

In the meantime, the Federal Center for Disease Control states that the best precaution is good hygiene. We have reminded our students and staff to follow proper germ prevention methods, including washing hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, covering coughs and sneezes with an elbow or tissue, and staying home when sick.
