We're starting our 6<sup>th</sup> week of the COVID-19 crisis. I hope your child is now on a regular schedule with their daily academics. Here is friendly guidance on how you can support your child:

- If you have access to a laptop, tablet or smartphone, please make sure that your child is logging in daily to our K-12 ELA and math online learning platforms through our Clever portal and completing their assignments.
- Ask your child to complete assignments in the printed student work packet that was mailed to your home address.
- Have your child complete at least 30 minutes of independent reading (or a read aloud by an adult or older sibling for grades K-2) each day.
- If you have any questions about HAP, including login/access issues to online learning platforms or additional clarification on HAP work your student should be completing, please contact your child's HAP teacher.
